Possible Funding Sources

Scholarships – based on merit

Bursaries – based on financial need

Work Study – financial need-based, on-campus employment program (typically for upper year students only)

Student Lines of Credit – offered through banking institutions and credit unions

RESP's – through service provider

OSAP and other Provincial Aid – need-based government loans and grants



Eligibility and Criteria

- Automatically awarded (no application required)
- Final Average is calculated by Admissions Department
- Awarded in late Fall. Not able to be used as a payment or deferral toward your first installment of tuition

Continuing Admissions Scholarship	Unlimited	\$10,000 (\$2,500 Annually)	95% or higher
Western Scholarship of Excellence	Unlimited	\$2,000 each	90%-94.9%
Western Scholarship of Distinction	Unlimited	\$1,000 each	88%-89.9%



Admission Bursary

- Non-repayable funding given on the basis of demonstrated financial need of each individual student
- Bursary applied against <u>first</u> installment of tuition and appears as Anticipated Aid on the Student Center.

Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP's)

Your provider may require an <u>Official Western letter</u> or a <u>Third Party Form</u> completed and sealed by the Registrar's Office to validate registration.

- 1. Official Western Letter \$16 online, \$25 in-person
 - Processing time: 4 to 5 business days.
 - Ordering available online via Student Center, by mail, fax, or in person.

Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP's)

2. Third Party Forms - \$16 online, \$25 in-person

- Standardized form completed by Western (CST, Heritage, Knowledge First, Children's Education Savings Plans).
- Payment required prior to form completion. Payment form on the website:

www.registrar.uwo.ca > Services > Third Party Forms

- Completed forms are sealed, and mailed directly to the organization requesting the verification.
- Forms/letters requiring verification for future terms are completed once registration is displayed in our Administrative System.



Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP)

OSAP is a form of financial assistance that is meant to supplement student and family resources.

Dates and Deadlines

- Application for 2019-2020 is now available online
- Apply and submit required documentation by June 30, 2019 to process before September



OSAP 2019-2020

Canada Study Grant: up to \$4,500 per academic year.

Ontario Grants – based on income thresholds.

Maximum Assistance (Grants + Loans)

Single Dependent/Independent Student

- \$13,200: \$400 per week for a 33 week study period
- Married/Sole-Support Student
 - \$22,240: \$680 per week for a 33 week study period




Receiving OSAP funding

- Tuition & Residence fees will be automatically remitted from the OSAP funding
- Fees not covered by OSAP funding must be paid by the tuition due date
- OSAP is distributed once Western completes a Confirmation of Enrollment
- Check status for completed file on Student Center

First installment due date: August 1: Approx. 50% of Tuition + Residence due Check your Detailed Statement of Account


Second installment due date: December 2: Remainder of balance

Outstanding balances are subject to late payment charges

Admission Bursary can be deducted from first installment – Look under Anticipated Aid

Scholarships are applied in the Fall against remaining tuition balance
